Heli Sightseeing

The Bella Coola Valley has one of the most unique combinations of ecosystem and geological beauty in Canada. It varies from high ice-covered mountain peaks and glacier fields to long ocean fjords and magnificent rainforests. However, like much of the country along Highway 20, this extraordinary viewscape is not fully accessible except by air and going by helicopter is the ultimate in sightseeing. Unlike fixed wing, a



helicopter allows you to land almost any where and in the Bella Coola Valley and surrounding areas, there are many marvelous possibilities ranging from thrilling adventure skiing, hiking and fishing to a relaxing picnic aside a remote alpine lake.

Visit Eucott Hot springs or hop to Larso Bay for a visit to a 1,000 year old giant Cedar Tree. Sightsee over majestic glaciers and snow-capped mountains on your way to fabulous Hunlen Falls, the third largest freefalling waterfall in Canada – all amazing flights.

Flights

You may wish to take a short flight over the rugged peaks overhanging the Bella Coola Valley and see the fjords that cut deeply into this coastline making it strikingly similar to the fjords of Norway, one of the main reasons the Valley was so heavily settled by Norwegians over a century ago. You can choose to land on a mountain top for a hike where in high summer you'll find a wondrous display of colourful wildflowers in high alpine meadows, view stunning waterfalls and incredible mountain vistas. Or choose to set down on the magnificent Monarch Glacier where you can explore close-up the beauty of ancient glacier ice.



Fishing

A helicopter charter is a great option for fishing enthusiasts where you can be taken in to remote fly-in lodges or dropped off for the week and camp next to a premier gravel beach fishing hole. Go for Steelhead, Trout, Chinook, Pink, Coho or Chum Salmon, depending on the time of year and fishing location, or change it up and relax riverside fishing for Cutthroat Trout and Dolly Varden.



The mountain ranges surrounding the Bella Coola Valley are world renowned for their quality of snow and that most holy grail of all, untracked deep powder!
