## Nimpo Lake Community Trails

The Nimpo Lake Community Trails have recently been developed for multi use, including hiking, mtn biking, geo caching, snow shoeing and cross country skiing and are geared for every age and ability.

The trailhead and kiosk with map are located in downtown Nimpo Lake at the Community Hall. The loops vary in distance and are well marked with color coding and maps at intersections.

Connecting with nature, the trails wind through pine forests and provide many opportunities to enjoy the amazing scenery, spectacular viewpoints and catch a glimpse of the many species of wildlife that inhabit this diverse ecosystem. The trails have benches in scenic locations, should you choose to pack a lunch and have a picnic, or want to sit and take in the beautiful canvas that mother nature provides.

Mountain bikers can also enjoy the trails with their flat winding sections as well as challenging elevation gains and fun downhills. Cross country skiers can also get out and ski these trails which are track set by volunteers. If snowshoeing is your winter activity, you can trek around the loops as well as challenge yourself to get to those awesome viewpoints! Or try your luck on Nimpo Lake where in the winter, when the days are amazingly sunny and calm, cross country skiing or snowshoeing on the lake is unbeatable.

There is an additional extensive network of trails surrounding Nimpo Lake of around 47km that are marked and with signage that can be accessed from both Nimpo Lake Rd. North and Nimpo Creek Road. Maps can be found at the information kiosk. This network is a multi-use trail system used by hikers, bikers, snowmobilers, snowshoers, cross country skiers and ATVs.
